THE GRAND ASSEMBLY BANNER PARADE TRADITION CONTINUES

What To Do:

Have fun getting together with your Assembly members to make your banner. And just think of all the uses for your new banner - parades, fundraisers, community events, membership parties, or display at Dream Camp. It's another great way of getting the word out about Rainbow.

Specifications:

- Your banner should be no bigger than 3' x 5'
- Include your Assembly name and number
- You may attach it to a pole, like a traditional parade banner
- Please do not use anything that could fall off your banner, such as glitter, sequins, or other loose objects

Categories:

- Best use of *Grand Assembly* theme
- Best Representation of Membership
- Representative of your Assembly's general area - geographic, community, social, etc. (what is your area/town most known for?)
- Most Creative

Turn in your banner after the first session of *Grand Assembly* (in the West). Be sure to include a brief explanation of what your banner represents and why you chose your theme. Judging will be done prior to the banner parade at *Grand Assembly*.
