The Results from not receiving Burn Children Recovery Foundation's Recovery Treatment!

Samantha burned at age 7 face hands, arms. Now at age 23 Samantha (not her real name) is living in a state funded home. She is receiving DSSI, deals with panic attacks, depression; reclusive living in a 10 foot by 12 foot bedroom watching T.V. She could not receive any surgeries because of the panic attacks.

Best case results after receiving counseling and help from the BCRF. Daddy please doesn't be mad at me! She is a child from Idaho. She was in a house fire caused by burning candles. Natasha (not her real name) was burned at age 7 and has attended Camp Phoenix, and has received emotional support, counseling, from the BCRF since 1995. Now at age 16 she has stayed in school, and learned to overcome and control her emotions. She is currently planning to attend college and live a full and productive life.

Gina (Not her real name) was burned at age 3 lost her right leg from the knee down, caused by the burns. She has dealt with depression, has attempted suicide, and is now 18 and returned to our camp in 2004 as a Jr. Counselor. She stayed in school and graduated with very high marks in the spring of 2005. She has a goal of continuing her education by going through college and becoming a special education teacher, as well as to continue to help and encourage other burn children.

Ashley (Not her real name was burned at age 6 she has lost all her fingers, face, and upper part of her body. She has many very visible scars. She is dealing with depression and has attended our camp since 1998. She has returned to public school and is now 11 years old. She comes to our Phoenix house every year before camp. Her usual stay at the Phoenix house is about a month prior to camp. She is doing very well. We have paid her airfare, clothing, and counseling during her recovery.

Nathaniel (not his real name) attended our camp for the first time at age 15. That was in 1991. He continued to attend camp until 1999. He was burned over 85% of his body. He lost all of his fingers, ears, lips, nose and most of his toes. After he received counseling, he spent a lot of time at the Phoenix house in 1995 and is now age 29 lives a full and productive life.

Kimmy (not her real name) was burned at age 3 and attended Camp Phoenix from 1990-1998. Burned over 60% of her body, her left arm was amputated. She stayed at the Phoenix house in 1993 and came back to camp as a staff counselor in 1998. She has since married and is now a mother and lives a full and productive life.

Susan (not her real name) came to camp in 1996 at age 10 and had 60% of her body burned, both hands were amputated to the wrist. She lost both her ears, and her nose. She was reclusive and would only leave her home for surgeries and camp. Now at age 19 she has won a world achievement award for the best up coming artist. She was the 1<sup>st</sup> child to ever receive this award in Russia. She now sells her artwork and is living a full and productive life.
