GRAND WORTHY ADVISOR FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS

The Grand Assembly of Washington Idaho has budgeted TWO payments of \$500.00 each to be paid to the presiding Grand Worthy Advisor in July following elections and the following January. This must be voted upon each fiscal year by the Grand Executive Committee. This money is designated for miscellaneous expenses incurred during the year. They include:

- Postage
- Pictures
- Business Cards
- Telephone Cards for Long Distance calls
- Copy Work/Printing
- Gifts for Official Visits to Mother Advisors and Worthy Advisors
- Gifts for Grand Officer Receptions
- Miscellaneous expenses for cards, organizer and office supplies

Designated travel expenses will be reimbursed only with a receipt. i.e, cash register receipts, gas receipts, copies of charges if applicable at concordant conventions. Submit to Supreme Inspector for a signature, then to the Finance Committee for a reimbursement check payable to you. (See Roster)

The GWA should travel with the Supreme Inspector to all official visits. If she chooses to travel in a separate car to an Official Visit, the mileage will not be covered, unless approved by the Supreme Inspector or Finance Committee.

Out of state transportation expenses are not a covered expense for the GWA. Most jurisdictions will provide complimentary Registration and Housing (4/room) while you attend the Grand Assembly session. Please be advised the GWA is a role model for the girls in her jurisdiction. When visiting other jurisdictions the GWA will not skip any sessions unless excused by the Supreme Inspector or Tour Director for illness or an emergency.

Supreme Sessions – Covered expenses are round-trip airfare, Dress Registration, Grand Cross Breakfast and Supreme Banquet. Incidental activities, meals and items are not covered.

Grand Assembly of Washington Idaho – Housing, registration and meals are all complimentary for the GWA. Incidentals are not covered.

Grand Officer Workshops (2) are complimentary.

I agree to participate in the jurisdiction Charity projects, the fund raising events for The National Children's Cancer Society, hands on community service projects, membership and leadership programs and Grand Officer practices as well as retreats and emergency meetings.

I agree to abide by the morals, standards and expectations of the International Order of the Rainbow for Girls.

I agree to cooperate with the Grand Worthy Advisor, the Grand Line, Grand Officers and all Advisors during the time I am an elected officer.

I agree to the guidelines for clothing/style if elected as a representative for Rainbow Girls in Washington Idaho at all times.

I will abstain from all facial piercings including my tongue, while I am a Grand Line Officer. I have been advised that if I break this rule the consequence is immediate removal from my Grand Office.

Stipulations:

- A Grand Officer may be INSTALLED at Grand Assembly PRIOR to or on her 20th birthday only.
- All Grand Line Officers must pass the proficiency exam within one month of Grand Assembly Installation if they have not done so previously.
- Grand Line Officers must memorize their Initiation work immediately and be prepared to act as a pro-tem officer if called upon at any time.
- Grand Line Officers are required to pay all financial obligations in a timely manner WITHOUT reminders.
- Grand Line Officers must BE SUPPORTIVE of the GWA and her goals.
- Grand Line Officers must agree to provide leadership within their assembly, their district and the jurisdiction.
- Grand Line Officers must keep the Director of Grand Officers and their Grand Deputies apprised of their schedule for school and work if it precludes their attendance and participation in jurisdictional events. Participation is a crucial aspect of being a Grand Line Officer.
- Grand Line Officers must support and attend District functions and assembly activities during the year they serve as a Grand Officer.
- The District Grand Deputy must be contacted for District event absences.
