

MOTHER ADVISOR & ADVISORY BOARD INSTRUCTIONS

Every advisory board member that is eligible to vote, based on attendance requirements will receive an evaluation form. It is your ballot! If there is any discussion about an eligible girl, we respectfully request any parent or relative leave the meeting area.

All information is considered CONFIDENTIAL. It is not to be discussed outside an Advisory Board Meeting! The Mother Advisor will provide you with each girl's statistics before voting.

The form is a GRADING SYSTEM of 1 – 5, with ONE as the lowest grade and FIVE as the highest grade. (Refer to the statistics that have been provided for you before voting).

Grand Officers of RAINBOW are the PUBLIC RELATION TEAM for WASHINGTON IDAHO GIRLS. The girl you recommend should be mature, responsible, and reliable. A Grand Officer should be a LEADER, SERVICE ORIENTED, DEDICATED, and ABLE TO FOLLOW DIRECTIONS. She should possess poise and social skills. She must be willing to participate.

Before you proceed, keep in mind that a girl should not be nominated because she is a really nice girl, served as a Worthy Advisor a couple of times, is cute and bubbly, is the oldest, and it is her turn.

REQUIREMENT: A girl who has served as W.A. of the I.O.R.G. is eligible for consideration if she has fulfilled the requirements of that office with the approval of the advisory board.

AGE: A girl must be 16 years of age and /or entering her JUNIOR year in High School in September. Grand Officers must be INSTALLED on or BEFORE their TWENTIETH birthday.

GRAND CROSS: Not required, however, a girl that is being considered as a Grand Officer should have met all the requirements for Grand Cross Designation. It is a reflection of the SERVICE she has performed for her Assembly, District and RAINBOW.

PROFICIENCY: Ritual is a requirement!

ATTITUDE: She must be willing to take direction and instruction from local and jurisdiction advisors. She must be willing to continue working as an active member in her assembly and district.

IMAGE: A girl must adhere to the RAINBOW DRESS CODE and all expectations for her conduct while representing Rainbow as a Grand Officer.

When your ballots are complete, **fold them in half** and place them in the pre-addressed "Return" envelope. The envelope will be sealed and mailed by May 1.

_____ **RITUALISTIC PERFORMANCE** - A rating of "5" reflects letter perfect ritualistic performance. As members progress through the line, it is expected they will memorize their work and present it in a near perfect manner.

_____ **FLOOR WORK** - A rating of "5" reflects an Officer who has obviously attended practices and paid attention, when other officers were performing. She is able to accomplish most floor work with ease and comfort.

_____ **COOPERATION** - A rating of "5" reflects an Officer who makes herself available to assist equally with "important" and menial tasks. A "5" indicates this Officer assists by filling vacancies and washing dishes!

_____ **DEPENDABILITY** - A rating of "5" reflects an Officer who signs up for an activity and then shows up, on time, at the appointed place, without several reminders. It also reflects an Officer who says, "I'll get back to you..." and DOES.

_____ **ATTITUDE** - A rating of "5" reflects an officer who cheerfully and graciously cooperates and demonstrates dependability. A high rating here indicates that this Officer always has her "Rainbow Smile" on, and projects encouragement, humility, kindness and consideration to all others.
