GRAND OFFICER APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- ◆ Applicants for a Rainbow Grand Office must be a Past Worthy Advisor or presiding as a Worthy Advisor during the term immediately preceding Grand Assembly sessions.
- ◆ An applicant must be at least 16 years of age and/or entering her junior year in high school in September following Grand Assembly sessions.
- ◆ An applicant must have satisfied all requirements pertaining to the office of Worthy Advisor, listed in the Jurisdiction handbook. This includes presiding at six stated meetings, including a minimum of two initiations and reciting the Ceremony of Initiation script and Secret Work by memory. Note: Initiation "Practice" will be considered providing the Mother Advisor or Board Chairman vouch that the Worthy Advisor satisfies ritual work.)
- ◆ Applicants must complete, sign and date the Application Form.
- ◆ Applicants must review the information with their parent/guardian and obtain their signature including a date for approval and support.
- ◆ Applicants must write a brief (One Page Only) CONFIDENTIAL letter to the attention of the Supreme Inspector of Washington Idaho, reflecting your experiences in Rainbow, the value of the lessons taught in the Ritual and the reason you would like to be CONSIDERED for a Grand Office. Include any talents that you have for specific offices. Sign and date the letter BEFORE placing it in an envelope that should be SEALED. Write your name over the seal.
- ◆ Include a picture with the application for IDENTIFICATION purposes only. It may be a wallet size, 3 x 5 inches and no larger than 4 x 6 inches.
- ◆ The application, picture and sealed letter must be submitted to the Grand Deputy by her due date. Promptness is a consideration for processing applications.
